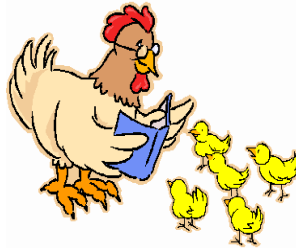

Friday, February 15th, 3:00-4:30 PM

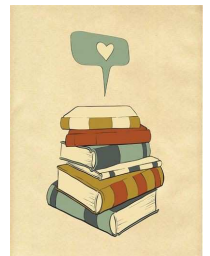
Join us to geek out over your favorite anime, practice manga-style drawing and make and enjoy crafts and snacks. All teen anime fans are welcome!
