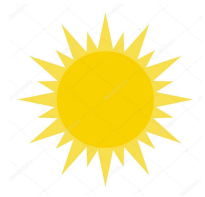


Free Youth Lunch - Monday-Friday until August 17th, 11:30 a.m.-12:00 p.m.

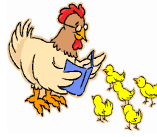

Teens in grades 6-12, drop in for crafts, video games, laptop computers and to hang out with friends in the community room.

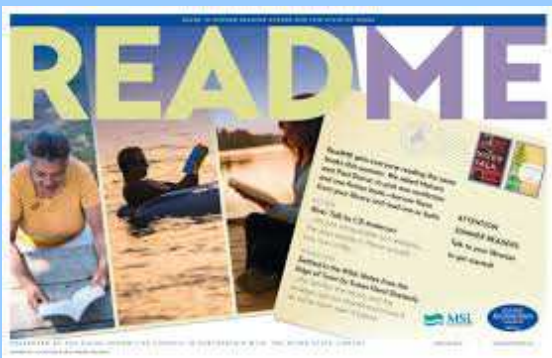
Teen Anime Club - Tuesday, July 17th, 2:00-3:30 p.m.

Book Ninjas Teen Book Group - Friday, July 27th, 3:30-4:30 p.m.

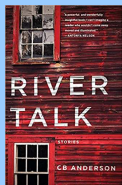
Avid readers in grades 6-12 are invited to our monthly teen book group. Pick from a large selection of advanced reader copies and talk about whatever you've been reading!
