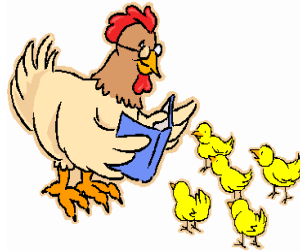

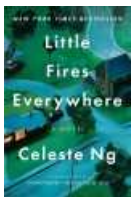
##### **Adult Book Group - Wednesdays, March 6th & 27th, 6:30-7:30 p.m.**
