

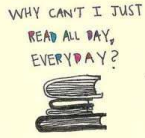

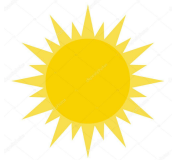


Tick Talk - Tuesday, June 19th, 6:30 PM

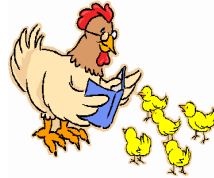
